


The description of any environmentally relevant activity (ERA) for which an environmental authority is issued is a restatement of the ERA as defined by legislation at the time the approval is issued. Where there is any inconsistency between that description of an ERA and the conditions stated by an environmental authority as to the scale, intensity or manner of carrying out an ERA, then the conditions prevail to the extent of the inconsistency.

An environmental authority authorises the carrying out of an ERA and does not authorise any environmental harm unless a condition stated by the authority specifically authorises environmental harm.

A person carrying out an ERA must also be a registered suitable operator under the *Environmental Protection Act 1994* (EP Act)

Contaminated land

It is a requirement of the EP Act that if an owner or occupier of land becomes aware a notifiable activity (as defined in Schedule 3 and Schedule 4) is being carried out on the land, or that the land has been, or is being, contaminated by a hazardous contaminant, the owner or occupier must, within 22 business days after becoming so aware, give written notice to the chief executive.

61(3)(a) **Incinerating waste** - Operating a waste incineration facility for incinerating **clinical waste** or quarantine waste.

Infectious Substances including but not limited to -
Discarded Sharps
Laboratory specimens and associated laboratory waste directly involved in specimen processing
Human tissues and anatomical waste, including materials or solutions containing free-flowing blood

61(3)(b) **Incinerating waste** - Operating a waste incineration facility for incinerating **regulated waste** (other than waste mentioned in paragraph in 61(3)(a).

Cytotoxic wastes
Pharmaceutical substances
Oil or reclaimed oil
Grease
Illicit drugs
Confidential material i.e. videotapes
Ringmain cleanings
Radiator fluid
Brake fluid
Absorbent material containing only waste oil
Rags contaminated with only ink and/or waste oil
Non-chlorinated solvents
Tyres
Dewatered sewage sludge
Chemical waste generated through the use of chemicals used in medical, veterinary and laboratory procedures
Waste from the production, formulation and use of photographic chemicals and processing materials*
Waste from the production, formulation and use of resins, latex, plasticisers, glues and adhesives*
Waste from the production, formulation and use of inks, dyes, pigments, paints, lacquers and varnish*
Packaging or plastic waste containing less than one percent (1%) residue of regulated waste*

* These waste streams can be incinerated at a maximum rate of two percent of the total throughput of the incinerator as prescribed in condition WA8 of this environmental authority.

55(1) **Regulated waste recycling or reprocessing** –operating a facility for receiving, storing and recycling or reprocessing no more than 10t of regulated waste in a day.
